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
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TIME-TESTED PEDAGOGY. MODERN APPROACH.

Driving intrinsic motivation for better learning outcomes

Classcraft's motivational approach is firmly based on <u>Self-Determination Theory</u>, a wellresearched psychological framework to explain what drives individuals to engage in specific activities. By fulfilling the players' needs for exercising control, developing competency, and experiencing relatedness, games are effective external systems to foster intrinsic motivation.





Cultural relevance

Games aren't just a part of youth culture, they define it. In fact, gaming leads every other cultural medium in terms of scale, be it films, TV, music, or professional sports. By creating a shared experience through games, Classcraft gives educators an authentic way to connect with students.



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Games promote equity

Inequity manifests when students don't have equal access to opportunity. Games and Classcraft are a true meritocracy. Whoever a student is, regardless of race or gender, have an equal opportunity to earn points, level up, and unlock real life privileges and digital swag. 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

Research has shown that PBIS is the best framework educators have for developing the competencies students need to become better learners and for preventing an escalation of negative behaviors. But when it comes to helping educators make sustained improvements to student behavior at the system-level — in a variety of settings — traditional implementations of PBIS can often fall short given the approach is typically based in giving extrinsic rewards for good behavior.





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
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MULTI-TIERED SYSTEMS OF SUPPORT

TIER 1: Universal prevention

Classcraft's Tier 1 behavior presets make it easy to develop skills and competencies by promoting positive behaviors schoolwide. Its data enables educators to identify at-risk students and use targeted and individualized intervention to help them get back on track.

TIER 2: Targeted prevention

Once you've identified students with Tier 2 or Tier 3 needs, how do you help teachers consistently support them? In Classcraft, behavioral teams can support students with Tier 2 and 3 needs by identifying behaviors and strategies for their success.

TIER 3: Individualized prevention

Assign appropriate strategies and behaviors to students and automatically sync them to all teacher accounts. This allows teachers to reinforce specific behaviors for students with particular needs, while reinforcing Tier 1 expectations for their entire class.

Classcraft's curriculum engine, Quests, are completely designed around RTI best practices and differentiated instruction.



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INSPIRED SEL

Develop studen'ts emotional skills for the long term as they master their ability to navigate emotions, reactions, and relationships. From the ground up, Classcraft helps educators integrate CASEL's five core SEL competencies: self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making.

Classcraft provides over 80 hours of story-driven SEL curriculum targeted specifically for higher elementary and middle school students. The lessons align with CASEL and use our proprietary Quest engine to motivate students and create opportunities for differentiated instruction. As an example, a lesson plan may involve a narrative that asks students to reflect on their personal qualities and how useful they can be during difficult times; students may be asked to participate in a class discussion; to team up with a partner for discussion; to create a drawing, story, poem, or other artistic expression, among many other practical exercises. Improve academic outcomes as students develop the ability to make constructive choices, take responsibility, and problem solve.



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FEDERAL FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FOR CLASSCRAFT

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (**CARES Act**) set aside \$13.5 billion for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER).

- **ESSER** money goes directly to state educational agencies, which will distribute at least 90% of those funds to local education agencies to address the impact of COVID-19.
- **ESSER** is flexible and meant to get money into districts' hands as quickly as possible
- Remote learning: **ESSER** is intended in part to fund solutions that facilitate remote learning, such as Classcraft.
- The **CARES Act** allows districts to carry over as much Title I money as they want into the 2021-2022 school year.
- The Act also waives requirements for needs assessments, content-specific spending requirements, spending restrictions on technology infrastructure, and a definition of "professional development."





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ESSA

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) is the federal law that governs elementary and secondary education in the U.S. Educators using Classcraft can qualify for ESSA funding under Title I, Title II or Title IV.
